HOW HAS THE HISTORICAL CONTEXT HAVE INFLUENCED THIS TEXT?

- Chicano is a term that became popular for 1960's for Mexican-american civil rights.
- La raza comes from La Raza Cosmico the cosmic race that started in the 20's and 30's. By Jose V.
 Because Mexico was a mixture of all these different races that are mixed into Mexican blood that they represent a cosmic race was to create pride
- Chicano fist had a bad connotation, but after the civil rights movement it was a way to represent where they are coming from. It connects to the indigenous culture they are coming from.
- Chicano came from work Mechico translation from the native language. It is sort of a reclaiming of indigenous identity that had at that point been white washed. Reclaiming that part of your identity was import.
- The term Chicano was first used by wealthy Mexican-Americans against Mexican-Americans with lower social class as an insult. (Ex: turn the term; queer; pachuco)
- Hispanic is a term to capture all Spanish speaking brown people. It was annoying to Chicanos because it included a catch all term that included Spaniard who conquered the America's.

HOW HAS HISTORY OF INDIGENOUS/ MECHICAN/CHICANO PEOPLES BUILT INTO BMU?

- There are certain key switches in words that are on purpose. They put hispanic on people to oppress them, likewise the way Ton. is combined with La Virgin. Antonio is fighting back against. Chicano use the movement to fight back against gov.
- I always assume that they were Mexicans living in New Mexico. I can no longer put them in their shoes. I feel like I don't know what is going on in my own mind
- BMU all the characters are very different. Similar to missionaries the church sets beliefs and traditions. The town goes with the Euro traits and Narciso and Jason do not fit into these Euro traits and pushed out.

- Past people embraced the virgin and even the town embraces. When Antonio has conflict with the church he is really having a conflict with his history. He is really questioning if he is embracing his colonized background or not.


